Our 2010 format is based on the YMCA's core values and mission of building a healthy spirit, mind and body. Our activities are guided by the core values of Caring, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty and Faith. We feel these are tools children need to build a future with strong kids, strong families and strong communities.

How does the Rides In System work?

Rides In starts at 7:00 a.m. and parents can drop off their children in the car pool lane by the gym. A staff member will be there to greet your child and help them out of the car. After 7:45 a.m. parents can walk their child into the gym and a staff member will be directly inside the door to check them in.

Where do they go when they get to the YMCA?

A counselor will be waiting for your children in the gym with a variety of rides in games and activities.



Is breakfast provided during Early Arrivals?

The YMCA does not provide breakfast for your child. However, children may bring their breakfast from home and eat it once they arrive at the EA program. When the school bell rings at 8:45am children are allowed to purchase school breakfast before they head off to class.

What if the start time for school is delayed due to inclement weather?

If schools are delayed, all morning YMCA programs are delayed by the same amount of time (i.e. if school starts 2 hours late, Early Arrivals will start 2 hours late).
