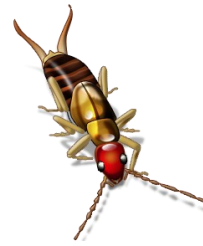


Getting Buggy

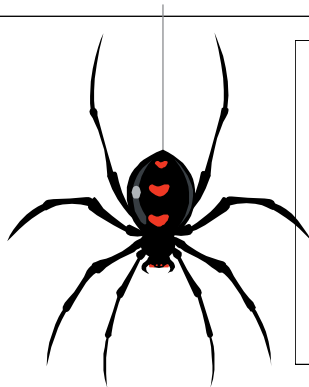

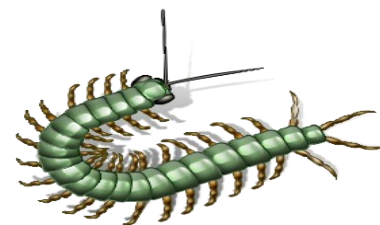
