## What does Tracking Out cover?

The Tracking Out program provides care for children while they are tracked out from school as outlined by the Wake County Public School System. Teacher Workdays and Student Holidays (orange days on the Year Round calendar) are not covered by the Tracking Out program. Most of these days are covered by the School's Out Special (SOS) program and must be purchased separately from Tracking Out.

**Schools served:** Timber Drive Elemen., Rand Road Elementary, East Garner Elementary, Barwell Road Elementary, Vance Elementary, Willow Springs Elementary, Banks Road Elementary, North Garner Middle and West Lake Middle

## What are Clinics?

Clinics are skill development activities that are held through a Track Out period. The children will sign up for the clinic that interests them the most. Clinic choices may include: soccer, basketball, drama, drawing, jump rope, music, flag football, cheerleading or creative arts.

## What about Field Trips?

Each group (K-3 or 4-Middle School) goes on two field trips per week. Field trips can be both educational and fun. Field trips might include roller skating, bowling, the North Carolina Museum of Life and Science, the History Museum, Morehead Planetarium, Wii Bounce, Cold Stone Creamery and many more depending on the track theme.

## What about Swimming?

Each group (K-3 or 4-Middle School) has two swim days per week at the Alexander Family YMCA indoor pool. Lifeguards are always on duty and floatation devices are available if needed. Tracking Out staff accompanies children to the pool locker rooms to change and they swim with the children. Afterwards, Tracking Out staff monitors the pool locker rooms and escorts children to the bus.

## What other activities do we offer?

We provide a variety of activities for our campers at the YMCA. We balance indoor with outdoor activities and active with passive games. We offer programmed activities that are led by our program coordinator and staff. On a daily basis, campers may have time on the playground, play gym games such as Gladiator or Spider Ball. We use field space for soccer, kickball and tag games. Large classroom space gives campers the opportunity to also participate in Arts and Crafts



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**What is an Assembly?**

Assembly is our way to get all of the huddles together and have fun as a large group. Skits, contests, counselor and camper challenges, along with cheers, songs and laughter are what your camper will come home talking about. We also recognize individual campers with assembly awards such as camper of the day and character awards.

**What are my options for my child's Summer Track Out?**

If you are registered for 4-Break Tracking Out, your child will be incorporated into our Summer Day Camp programs--

**Camp Great Adventure** for rising grades K-5 or **Camp Upward Bound** for rising grades 6-9. Parents must drop off and pick up at the Summer Day Camp location. Transportation is not provided during your child's summer track out.

**What should my child bring to Tracking Out each day?**

Children attending a full day of Tracking Out should bring:

- Lunch (including drinks)
- Two healthy snacks (with drinks)
- Swimsuit and towel

\*\*Refrigeration and a microwave are not available so please keep that in mind when packing lunches and snacks.

\*\*Water is available throughout the day.

\*\*On Field Trip days, please do not send any extra money with your child unless it is requested by the Tracking Out Staff.

\*\*Please be sure to label ALL of your child's belongings with their name, school and Track number.

**What if I want to pick up my child early?**

If you need to pick up your child before they leave to go back to their After School program, please call the Tracking Out site phone (412-6061) so we can let you know where your child will be at the time you need to pick him/her up. Please have your picture identification or Pick-up Card available so the staff can verify your identity.

**Where does my child go in the afternoons?**

At 3:00 p.m. your child will be bused to their respective After School site.

Please see below for where you will pick up your child each day by 6:00 p.m.

- Vance, Rand Road, Banks Road students – **Vance Elementary**
- Timber Drive, East Garner Elem., Barwell, Road Elem., Willow Springs Elem. students– **Timber Drive Elementary**
- Middle school students – **East Garner Middle School**

**What do I need to do if I know my child will be absent from Tracking Out?**
