Transportation Details:

The YMCA uses a bus to pick program participants up from Edwards Elementary and then travels to pick up students at Greenwoods Elementary where a counselor waits with the children until the bus arrives. Once both schools have been picked up the bus brings the students to Tramway by 3:10 p.m. every day.
