

In order to ensure the health and safety of all, the YMCA of the Triangle will follow the below listed daily screening process. This screening will be used for any staff, participants, volunteers or others who will be involved in YMCA programming.

ALL individuals (employees, members, program participants, volunteers and vendors) entering the building must be asked the following questions:

1.	minutes) in the	al entering the program or facility had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, or has any health department provider been in contact with them and advised them to quarantine?
		The individual should not be at the child care facility. The individual can return 14 days after the last time he or she had close contact with someone with COVID-19, or as listed below.
		The individual can be at the facility if he or she is not experiencing symptoms.
2.	Does the individual entering the program or facility have any of these symptoms?  Fever Chills Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing New cough New loss of taste or smell	
		has any of these symptoms, they should go home, stay away from other people, and the should call the child's health care provider.

4.	Check temperature: is fever present? – STAFF & YOUTH PARTICIPANTS ONLY.  Fever is defined as 100.4°F. If touchless thermometer is not available, use a tympanic (ear) or temporal (forehead) thermometer. Do not take temperatures orally.   YES
