When does Camp Blazing Trails operate?

Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. (NO CAMP MONDAY JULY 4th)

Where is Camp Blazing Trails located?

Camp Blazing Trails is located at Blue Jay Point County Park, 3200 Pleasant Union Church Rd. Raleigh 27614.

Can I drop my child off early?

For the safety of your child, we cannot allow children to be dropped off prior to Rides In while our staff are setting up for camp, as we cannot ensure proper supervision.

What happens if I'm late to pick up my child?

Parents arriving after 1 p.m. will be issued a late fee of \$5 for parents arriving prior to 6:10 p.m. and \$1 for every minute thereafter.

Where should I go if I need to drop off late or pick my child up early?

If you are arriving between 9:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., please call the camp number at 919–815–1242. Our staff will come to you to sign your child in or out. Please be aware that it may take extra time as we are out and about in the park. If needed, please call or text our number so we can be prepared for a faster transition.

How do drop-off and pick-up work?

From 8:30 a.m. – 9: 00 a.m. we run Rides In, and from 12: 30 – 1 p.m. we operate Rides Out. Rides In and Rides Out are a curb-side pickup for your convenience and we will escort your child to/from your car. Please remain in your car, and our staff will help your child.

Rides In and Out are located in the playground parking lot of Blue Jay Point County Park. Follow YMCA signs from parks entrance to playground. During inclement weather or high temperatures, Rides In/Out will take place at the Blue Jay Center (at the main entrance of the park). Parents must present a pick-up card (provided at Parent Orientation or your child's first day of camp) or an ID as a safety precaution. At registration, you can also place additional friends and families on your approved pick-up list to help us ensure the safety of your child.

What does my child need to bring to camp?

- Clothing that is appropriate for active play and close toed shoes suitable for running.
- Backpack with a bathing suit and towel on Thursdays for Water Day. Please come to camp in water clothes with extra change of clothes in backpack..
- Insulated lunch box or cooler with a healthy and hearty lunch, two snacks and a reusable water bottle.

Walking Sticks

Trademark of Camp Blazing Trails! The sticks are a symbol of pride and accomplishment. Bring on your first day of camp! Staff will wood burn BT and year into stick. We will also add string for your camper to add their beads to each day. All sticks need to come from home and not from the park.
