Celebrating Five Years of Community Impact

For over 50 years, the YMCA of the Triangle has supported youth in Southeast Raleigh through vital programs and services.

In 2012, inspired by the strength and potential of the community, YMCA leaders and local volunteers came together to dream bigger—to envision a place where opportunity, equity and connection could thrive side by side.

That vision took root in 2016, when the YMCA of the Triangle purchased 32 acres along the Rock Quarry Road corridor. The plan was bold: build a full-service YMCA, an elementary school, affordable housing and community spaces—all on one site. It would become a Beacon for the Community.

In 2019, the Southeast Raleigh YMCA opened its doors. And today, that bold vision is fully realized. **The Beacon Site stands as a vibrant hub of learning, wellness and belonging—built with and for the people of Southeast Raleigh.**



Each day, the Southeast Raleigh YMCA and its partners work to serve the community based on the YMCA's three areas of impact—

We are proud to celebrate more than five years of innovative, accessible programs for children, families and adults in Southeast Raleigh. And we recognize the collective dream realized through collaborative partnerships that help lead and coordinate these efforts.

COMMUNITY HEALTH & WELL-BEING

Non-medical factors such as environments where people live, learn, work and play can also drive population health outcomes. The Southeast Raleigh Y has the long-standing track record and on-the-ground presence necessary to address our community's most pressing social issues.

Since 2020 at the Southeast Raleigh Y:

- 714,144 healthy meals served to 23,627 individuals
- 1,020 volunteers participated in health services
- 641 COVID-19 vaccinations administered
- 29,760 diapers distributed to 512 children

Through Y Health, participants have access to evidence-based health programs like:

- YMCA Diabetes Prevention Program
- LIVESTRONG at the YMCA
- Moving for Better Balance
- Healthy Weight and Your Child
- Weight Management Programs



DROWNING PREVENTION

Our pool provides valuable access to **Swim Instruction, Family Swim** and **Aquatic Fitness Programs**.

Southeast Raleigh Elementary is the only Wake County school with a swimming pool. As part of the physical education curriculum, **more than 800 students in grades 1 – 5 have participated in swim lessons since 2020.**

In total, more than **1,600 people (preschool – adult) have received swim instruction from the Southeast Raleigh Y**, including 127 community members who participated in the Swim for Life program sponsored by Delta Airlines in 2024 – 2025.



ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Our Y offers impactful and engaging programs that support schools, students and educators by boosting learning opportunities and sparking new experiences.

- 500+ students received academic and social-emotional support through Club ROAR After School since 2019.
- 529 students currently participate in YMCA After School, Before School and Track Out programs. 129 participate on scholarship.



COMMUNITY HUB

The **SECU Beacon Site** serves as a community hub for innovative programming through collaborations with other agencies.

- Since 2019, the Southeast Raleigh Y has hosted 100+ Community Engagement Events with more than 10,000 individuals participating.
- In 2022 and 2024, the Southeast Raleigh Y served as an early voting site engaging 18,360 voters.



ECONOMIC IMPACT

Since 2020, the Southeast Raleigh YMCA has **spent \$1.1 million supporting local, minority-owned businesses**. Today, 50+ diverse companies are official YMCA vendors.

In 2025, the Southeast Raleigh Y **will employ more than 250 staff, with a deliberate focus on hiring from within our service area**. Together, this team will serve nearly 12,500 children, teens and adults through impactful programs and membership opportunities.

Through five certification-based training programs, 80+ adults completed programs that enhance **Workforce Development**.

Beacon Ridge: This DHIC mixed-income housing development on the SECU Beacon Site opened with 120 units in 2024. Today, all units are occupied. Zone pricing for a YMCA membership is offered to all residents.

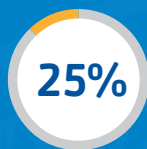
