
Health & Community Well-Being

Southeast Raleigh YMCA

- Community Baby Shower (May 2024): 175 attendees, 27% from 27610; Partner: WakeMed Birth and Family Education.
- Free Community Cooking Classes: Hosted by NC
 Cooperative Extension, featuring a 6-week "Nutrition Bites"
 course covering nutrition, food safety, resource
 management, and physical activity.
- Black Farmers' Market: 14 market events, increasing fresh food access.
- Black Family Wellness Expo: 400 attendees; screenings for blood pressure, cholesterol, cancer, mental health, and heart health; fitness classes and massages. Partner: The Raleigh NC Links.
- Advance Community Health Partnership: Diabetes
 Management Program led by a Health Equity Coordinator.
- Monthly Mobile Food Distributions: 124,578 meals provided;
 4,868 individuals served; 200+ volunteers.
- Black Fathers Summit: 26 participants; mental and physical health focus; screenings by Advance Community Health.
- Advance Community Health Block Party: 1,500 attendees; giveaways included 350 backpacks and 18 refurbished laptops







- Swim for Life Community Swim Lessons: 100 participants (preschool to adult).
- Soul Care Sunday: 30
 participants; activities included
 line dancing, Afrobeat yoga,
 and meditation.
- Hispanic Heritage Event: 60 attendees, performances by Venezuela es Danza, Flor de Hidalgo, and Folklore NC.
- Juneteenth Health Fair & Expo: 25% attendance from 27610; services provided by Advance Community Health, WakeMed, and Invision Diagnostics.
- Diabetes Prevention Program: Partnering with YMCA of the Triangle for in-person diabetes prevention classes.






Cradle to Career Education

Southeast Raleigh YMCA

- Teen Fellowship Workforce Development: 6-month program; 18 graduates; 11 employed at SER YMCA.
- Education in Advocacy: Partner: Advocacy and Consulting Solutions; 71% of participants from 27610.
- SWIM 1922 Event: Partnership with USA Swimming and Sigma Gamma Rho to improve swim proficiency.
- Teen Fellowship Paid Internship: 26 fellows; 27610
 zip code applicants tripled.
- Swimming Proficiency: Nationally, 64% of African
 American children have minimal to no swimming
 ability, compared to 40% of Caucasian children. Black
 children (ages 10-14) drown at rates 7.6 times higher than White children.








Economic VitalitySoutheast Raleigh YMCA

- Black & Minority-Owned Business Vendor Spending:
 \$251,564 total, including \$42,548 with Black
 farmers/grocers.
- Real ID Community Drive: Addressing barriers to employment.
- Mama Afrika Festival: 12th annual event.
- Workforce Development Training: 8-week Baking &
 Culinary class in partnership with Wake Tech.
- Black Farmers' Market: 14 events with 30+ vendors.
- Women's Empowerment Conference: 5-week program hosted by The Encouraging Place.









Mixed Income Housing & Real Estate

Southeast Raleigh YMCA

- Walnut Creek Stakeholder Event: Partnered with Partners for Environmental Justice for community input on rezoning.
- MLK Day of Service: Donations of toiletries and food distributed to South Wilmington Street Shelter, Oak City Cares, and Revelation Missionary Baptist Church Food Pantry.
- Community Hub Space: Hosted 50+ events; provided \$23,000 in in-kind facility use donations.
- Case Management: Supported 15 families with therapy, clothing, insurance, and YMCA medical memberships; 25 children attended summer camp at reduced rates.
- Zone Membership & Program Pricing: Expanded programs in Summer Day Camp, Youth Sports, and Swim Lessons;
 30% participation growth.
- Early Voting Location: 13,000+ voter turnout; 17 days of operation.
